What do Saturday Volunteers do?

A volunteer at Chichester Child Contact Centre is primarily responsible for facilitating meaningful contact between a child or children and a non-resident parent or family member by:

- ✓ Helping to prepare the Centre before children arrive
- ✓ Welcoming families and showing them round
- ✓ Signing families in and out of the Centre
- ✓ Listening to adults and children without judging, advising or taking sides
- ✓ Making refreshments
- ✓ Cleaning or organizing toys
- ✓ Cleaning up the Centre once its closed

It is also important to note that volunteers should not:

- Be left unattended with the children they are always the responsibility of the parents
